Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

**Minutes:** Meeting minutes from April were accepted as presented.

**President's Report:** Nothing to report. Key dates were shared with all including, June 18<sup>th</sup> – last finals taken, 21<sup>st</sup> – last day of school and 20<sup>th</sup> – graduation.

**Correspondence:** Bank statements forwarded to Bonnie Cote (Treasurer) including a check in the amount of \$280 for deposit.

**Treasurers Report:** March expenses were \$237.00; deposits in March were \$1,055.96 which left in the checking & savings account a combined amount of \$16,368.35 as of April 7, 2010.

**Volunteer Report:** Terry Ux shared with all that the likely next event the Boosters will participate in will be the Incoming Parent/Freshman Night. Terry will recruit volunteers for this activity so the Boosters merchandise and volunteer forms will be on hand.

**Scholarships:** All applications received on or before deadline, that met the criteria were placed into a random drawing for selection of one of ten \$500 college scholarships for the upcoming school year. No names will be announced until the evening of June 16<sup>th</sup> when all scholarships will be announced at a special session held in the auditorium in the evening. Tom will coordinate with Pat Gallipeau who manages this event for the school such that all recipients will be invited to attend but will not know what scholarship they may be receiving.

**Fundraising Efforts:** Tom Conlon let everyone know that merchandise inventory levels were all set.

**Old Business:** Tom Conlon spoke to the comedian who recently was the entertainer at a Comedy Night held by the women's group at a local parish. While many details were shared – here is a recap of the highlights; cost of the even for the comedian is \$2,500, if we wanted a second comedian/entertainer it would be another \$500. Suggestion made to have such an event on a Saturday evening and the key to success is “advertising”. Evening is similar to a “Vegas” style of entertainment. Comedy is clean and fun in nature. All were excited to hear about this and asked to go off and ponder where such an event could take place for an October 2010 fundraiser and report back at the June meeting.

Joel Ackerman presented additional information on Scorers Tables and addressed questions that arose at the April meeting. Artwork is expected shortly – will present to the group for final selection at June meeting.

**New Business:** Martha Ackerman shared with all the formation of the “pay to play” committee and how this newly voted on program by the School Board is progressing and discussions on how to implement are in process. More to follow.

Mo Marquis thanked the Boosters for supporting the Heptathlon t-shirt fundraiser for the upcoming tournament. All proceeds do come right back to the Booster program and a hugely well attended event is expected again this year.
